



Start the trail at the grey arrow going into the Porch. Follow the numbers from 1 to 13





8 PISCINA

Find the small bowl in the wall at the side of the altar. Is there a drain hole? Yes / No What was it used for?





9 STAINED GLASS WINDOW Look at the stained-glass window

LOOK at the stained-glass window above the piscina. You will see Jesus on the cross.

What letters are written above Jesus?

What do you think these letters might mean? (Clue: think of I as J and R stands for Rex in Latin)

10 ALTAR AND ALTAR RAIL

The altar (a holy table) is at the east end of this church. Under the rail are cushions called hassocks. What are they used for?

11 THE MAYFLOWER MODEL

Beside the organ is a large-scale model of the Mayflower, which sailed from England across to America in 1620. What do you think the model is made from?

How many sails does the ship have?



12 THE MAYFLOWER PAINTING


Look to your left on the north wall. What church is shown in the background of the picture?

13 MEMORIAL WINDOW

On the north wall next to the painting is a memorial window. Draw and name what you see in the round centre panel.
